# Garfield Clean Energy Challenge for Homes



## HVAC EQUIPMENT UPGRADE REBATE RULES

**Who is eligible:** Households who have registered for the Garfield Clean Energy Challenge AND have **submitted their signed Utility Bill Release Form**. Official owners of record of a residential property located within Garfield County. Landlords are welcome to apply for rental properties located within Garfield County.

**What homes are eligible:** Single family homes, duplexes, triplexes and townhomes. New construction is not eligible.

### What HVAC upgrades and tune-ups are eligible:

- HVAC upgrades listed in table on page 1. Upgrades must meet required efficiency levels.
- Upgrades done by a licensed contractor – do-it-yourself projects are not eligible.
- Upgrades or tune-ups done on or after October 27, 2010, until program funds are depleted.

**Submit your complete rebate application** and documents within 60 days after your HVAC equipment upgrade or tune-up is complete. Funding is limited, so don't delay.

**Required documents:** Copies of ALL dated invoices and receipts, your IRS Form W-9 and utility release form must be submitted with rebate form. If you pay with a check, please include a photocopy of your canceled check. Your rebate application form also must be signed.

### Fine print

3. Your rebate check will be issued by Garfield County and the funds are ARRA funds from the Department of Energy, thus the requested paperwork is required.
